

³ Day pass 'In and out' privilege takes effect from the time of first entry and in effect for 24 hours. Valid only for one vehicle & is non-transferable. Must get receipt from attendant the first time vehicle exits & should be presented to the attendant each time when exiting. Call 604-909-3929 to register for the DHCC parkade one month pass.

⁴ All dialysis patients must obtain special parking permit at the Dialysis department and purchase the first 1/2 hour of parking.

⁵ All persons with disabilites must pay for parking and must display a valid permit issued by the SPARC BC.

⁶ Max. length approx. 20 ft; Do not block access to other parking stalls/entrance of building. No motorhomes or trailers. Located directly in front of the Health Centre North building in Lot 28. 24/7 meter parking.
