MESSAGE FROM CCI-CIC DIRECTORS

Dear colleagues,

CCI-CIC continues to make great progress on multiple fronts. We received unanimous support from DEX to formally become an FOM center at the full Faculty of Medicine meeting in November 2021. The growth of sponsor and investigator-initiated studies continues to provide overhead recovery to CCI-CIC with 17 investigator-initiated projects currently underway. The centre continues to grow with a total of 66 members and 39 affiliated research staff across the province (> 23 FTE). Annual funding has now surpassed 7 million CAD.

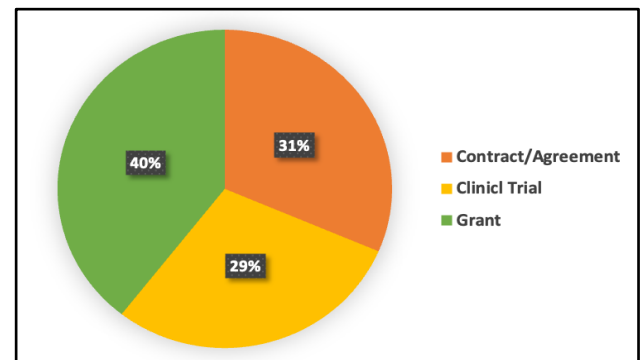

CCI-CIC ANNUAL FUNDING & PUBLICATIONS

Total funding from 27 out of 66 CCI-CIC investigators for the fiscal 2019-2020 is **\$7.3 Million**. 40% of the total research funding came from competitive research grants, 31% from contracts and agreements and remaining 29% from clinical trials.

Our statisticians help with SAP for all projects, perform power calculations, and respond to reviewer's comments related to statistical analysis

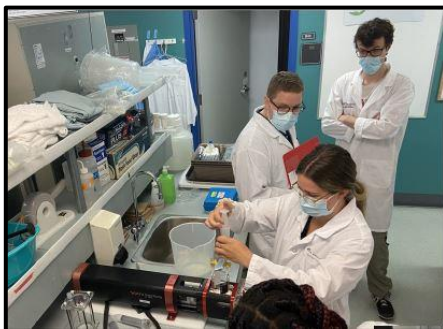
COMMON CV SUPPORT

Our staff help draft and collect all letters of support needed for full application

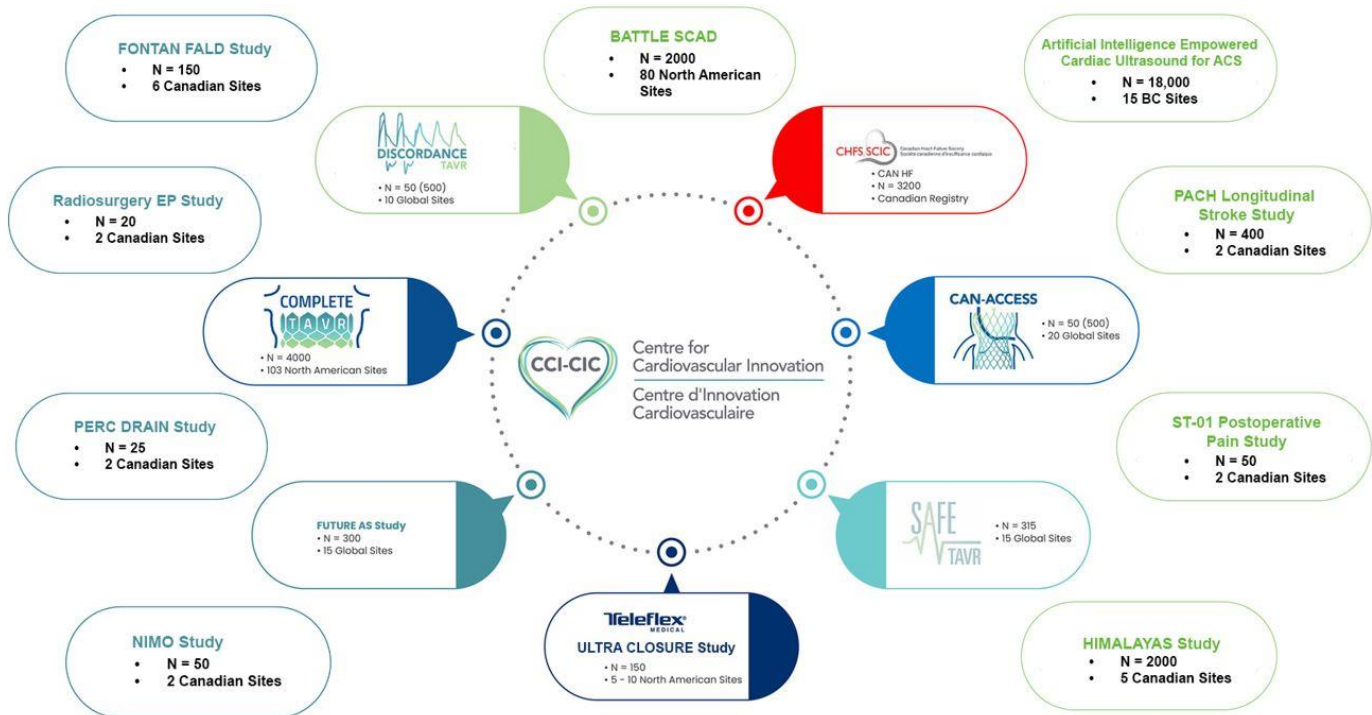
